




- Google Maps is probably installed on your phone. Look for the icon.
- Go to the app store on your phone if you can't find the app.
- Search for "Google Maps"

Open Your Web Browser

- Android, open Chrome
- iPhone, open Safari
- Navigate to oflags.org
- Note that it is ".org", not ".com"







Click on the blue "Open Navigator" button to start




How it Works

Overview

- Integrates your delivery route list to Google Maps
- Start Google Maps at any address by tapping the address
- There are 2 ways to populate waypoints in Google Maps from Navigator
 - Directions to every waypoint
 - Directions to each waypoint on a different street. (Does not mean only one point per street)
- You can reverse the order of your list
- You will need to get the password!
- This slide deck will be on the website







Brief Instructions are on the ٠ website itself

Basic

- First time you click on "Open ٠ Navigator" you will be asked for a password.
- The page is password protected and it will be on your printed route sheet.





Choose Your Route

- Click the drop down
- Scroll and select your route
- Your route will populate in the table below
- Note that you can turn your phone sideways to landscape and more addresses may show and some consider it easier to read
- For flag pickup some volunteers may like to see their route in reverse order
 - Click on "Switch to Descending Order"
 - You may be closer to Flag Headquarters at the end of pickup


Choose First Address for Google Maps


- Scroll to the address you want to begin ٠ your map session
- Google will only show 10 way points ٠
- Click the address to show the next 10 • addresses
- Google Maps Automatically OPENS! •
- Click the Stop number in the Stp column ٠ to show a condensed list
 - One address per different street ٠
 - This reduces having to flip back and forth ٠ between Google Maps and the list
 - Same street may show again depending ٠ on the sequence coded in the database

Directions in Google Maps

- Shows list of way points
- On Android click the Up Arrow in Bottom right of Google Maps.
- Access from clicking bottom of Google Maps on the time, then select directions.





Using on Android Device

Switching between Google Maps and Chrome Web Browser

Android Bottom Right Button

- Double tap to switch between 2 most recent apps
- If you have no recent button, then swipe up from the bottom
- If you don't have this button then swipe up from the bottom
- If you click the button it will list all open apps. Click the app you want to open
- You can close apps by swiping left or right on an app






Using on iPhone

Switching between Google Maps and Safari Web Browser


Open the App Switcher

- Double tap the home button
- If you have no home button (iPhone X and above), Swipe up from the bottom to the middle of your screen and hold until you see the App Switcher
- Swipe left or right to find the app that you want to use.
- Tap the app to open
- Trick: From Google Maps most of the time there is a "Safari" button in the upper left
- You can close apps by swiping up on an app after double clicking the home button




Save as a bookmark in Chrome on Android

- The address (URL) to save is
 - <u>https://oflags.org/cno</u>
 - It won't show the "/cno", but be on the page with addresses
- Tap the "Star" to the right of the address
- TRICK: To save to your HOME screen tap the three dots in the upper right
 - Click "Add to Home Screen"



Save as a favorite on iPhone


- The address (URL) to save is
 - <u>https://oflags.org/cno</u>
 - It won't show the "/cno", but be on the page with addresses
- Tap the share button, it looks like a square with an arrow pointing out of it
- Slide the screen up and choose "Bookmark" from the options
- The default location should be "Favorites", but tap on Location and select 'Favorites' if not
- Tap on "Save" to add the website to the Safari index Favorites page
- TRICK: You can choose "Add to Home Screen" instead of a bookmark





Save as a favorite on iPhone - continued

• The picture to the right is the list of options that shows when you slide the screen up after clicking the share button.





Troubleshooting

- "Unsupported link" error
 - Can happen after clicking an address
 - Close Google Maps and re-open
 - Happens when Google Maps navigation mode has been exited
- Google is your friend!
 - Search on "installing google maps"
 - "Switching apps on iPhone" or "Switching apps on Android"
